Extreme disruption to teaching staff last year meant my son's year has been disadvantaged. The constant change of staff has made it difficult to build a trusting teacher/pupil relationship

Early as possible for notification of star awards etc, as sometimes 24hrs notice is not enough – improve communication

Would like to see separate teaching year groups continue next year

When Reception and Year 1 can have their own classrooms (when numbers and funding allows)

½ termly sessions for forest school for KS2 children

Would have liked to have had an opportunity to meet my child's new teacher

Would love it to go to Year 6

I think everyone is doing a great job

Provide simple homework explanations for parents

A little more emphasis placed on children's personal hygiene

A little more structure with organised activities during Welcoming Wednesdays

More opportunities for parents to get to know each other

Offer more sports and more information on sports clubs, with all ages being able to participate in after school clubs

Increased parent/teacher contact

Refresher on phonics

Possible holiday club/summer camp?
