Elm Class Visit to the Black Country Museum

We have arranged for Elm Class to visit the Black Country Museum on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July as part of their Summer Term topic Travel & Transport Through the Ages. The children will have a chance to see a range of vehicles from the past, observe how they have changed through the ages and even get to ride on an old tram and train!

We shall be leaving school after registration and returning by the end of the school day. The children will need to wear school uniform, sunscreen and a hat. Children will need to bring a packed lunch (this will be provided for children in receipt of pupil premium, as will the cost of the trip) and water bottle which they will carry themselves in a rucksack.
